A highly detailed ink pen study of "Majesty" the Fredville Oak, seen by many tree lovers and experts as the most impressive Oak in Great Britain, listed in the Guinness Book of records as the largest maiden Oak tree in the country.

Majesty's trunk is over 12m circumference and the tree is well over 19m in height. In the early twentieth century the tree lost a large limb at 3 - 4 m height at the south side of the trunk; this created an enormous void, which shows the tree is totally hollow.

The drawing includes owls, squirrels, buzzard and sparrow hawk - a few of the many creatures found to dwell in these majestic trees.
